This term Year 11 students should be starting to apply for their Post-16 choices, whether that may be college, sixth form or training/apprenticeship schemes. Although many Post-16 providers will accept application in early 2024, Peter Symonds, for example, has a deadline of Monday 11th December 2023 for their applications, so please research this in good time. Besides the continued support of tutors and teachers, we also provide the following for all Year 11 students:

Post-16 Careers Fair - Thursday 23 November

All Year 11 students will be attending a Post-16 careers fair in the main hall during period 5 or 6. In attendance will be local colleges, sixth forms, training and apprenticeship providers as well as the armed forces. This will be a chance for you and your child to research which careers pathway will be right for them. If parents would like to attend, there will also be an open event between 2:40pm - 3:15pm where everyone is welcome.

Careers Appointments

All Year 11 students will have a face-to-face interview with our Level 6 careers advisor. They will provide them with impartial advice related to all pathways, in order to help students in making decisions about their future and reach their full potential. All appointments are scheduled in school time, with times and location provided by their tutor and feedback forms passed back to them in tutor time; these will often have follow-up tasks for the student to complete.

Labour Market Information

Alongside Post-16 providers' websites, please take time for you and your child to visit the parent and student careers sections of the school website. Here you can find useful website links, careers magazines and documents to support the students in securing their desired destination, such as apprenticeships and personal statements. When considering particular jobs roles, it is always worth researching the prospects of that career, vacancies in the job sector and whether it is future-proofed, many of the careers website links feature this kind of detail.
