





We continue to promote the progress the school is making and are pleased that 82% parents recognise the school's positive reputation.



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

A lot of work has taken place to embed our ethos within the school community and beyond. 86% parents agreed that this now has a high profile.



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

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

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

Our parents said...	Our response...
<p>One parent said that they would like there to be a sign in system during parents evening so teachers know who has arrived, so appointments do not run over. In addition to this, they would like a plan of where they can find teachers during parents evening.</p>	<p>We have previously had sign-ins but this was not popular with parents, many of whom did not sign in. A map of where to find staff would be helpful to parents. This has been shared with Assistant Headteacher, Mr Jones, to investigate whether this is practical.</p>
<p>One parent has asked to get a better understanding of the after school clubs available to students and another requested a wider range of opportunities.</p>	<p>We will improve the promotion of extracurricular activities. Teachers are continually considering different clubs to offer and we will conduct a student questionnaire to see what they would like. The summer clubs and classes programme can be found on the website: https://www.regentsparkcollege.org.uk/home/parents/clubs-and-classes/</p>
<p>Two parents would like to see more Year 11 students rewarded for their hard work.</p>	<p>We agree! A reminder has gone to teachers to ensure that Year 11s are rewarded as much as possible.</p>
<p>One parent would like better communication with the SENCO team. They have suggested more training to understand student's needs.</p>	<p>We have a new SENDCO so communication in this area should improve. We have also been attending additional training to make the school officially 'Autism Friendly'. Further updates on this will follow.</p>
<p>One parent felt that their child would like school lunches more, if there was more food variety provided and another commented that the preorder did not always work.</p>	<p>These comments will be shared with City Catering. Please continue to feedback on the food offered at school.</p>
<p>One parent requested more challenging homework and two were concerned that teachers were not following up on students not completing homework.</p>	<p>We have started a 'challenge' focus at school, which is also being shared with parents. This will include more challenging homework. Where students do not complete set work, this is recorded on SIMs for parental information.</p>
<p>One parent would like better communication, she feels as though there is different news on other social platforms.</p>	<p>All news is triangulated onto Facebook, Twitter and our website. Emails and occasionally text messages are sent to specific year groups or classes with pertinent information.</p>
<p>One parent has asked for a variety of different awards, they feel that certain rewards are not considered a 'reward' for students on the autism spectrum.</p>	<p>We reward students in a really wide range of ways, including achievement points, certificates and postcards, monthly calls home from HOYs and SLT, reward assemblies, tutor rewards ,prizes, ethos badges, DHT Awards, Bounceback Awards, Hot 50 and Hot Chocolate with the Headteacher. If individual students do not want to accept a prize or a reward we are always sensitive to this.</p>
