One parent has asked to get a better understanding of the after school clubs available to students and another requested a wider range of opportunities.	We will improve the promotion of extracurricular activities. Teachers are continually considering different clubs to offer and we will conduct a student questionnaire to see what they would like. The summer clubs and classes programme can be found on the website: https://www.regentsparkcollege.org.uk/home/parents/clubs-and-classes/ Since Spring, we have created a leaflet which gives information on what clubs are available, what they involve, who can attend and when they are on! This will be published shortly.
One parent would like better communication with the SENCO team. They have suggested more training to understand student's needs.	We have a new SENDCO so communication in this area should improve. We have also been attending additional training to make the school officially 'Autism Friendly'. Further updates on this will follow. Our SENDCO has completed the Autism Friendly training and we recently had a positive external audit of our provision. Mrs Bundy is providing bitesize weekly SEND updates and guidance as well as more formal staff training. This aspect of our CPD will continue to have a raised profile next academic year.
One parent requested more challenging homework and two were concerned that teachers were not following up on students not completing homework.	We have started a 'challenge' focus at school, which is also being shared with parents. This will include more challenging homework. Where students do not complete set work, this is recorded on SIMs for parental information. Our 'challenge' work is well underway with work, activities and students celebrated in school and on our social media. This will be embedded next year with students set even more challenging work. Consistency around homework will be a key driver next academic year.
