

## **Dear Parent**

What a wonderful start the students have made to this term. Despite the hottest weather of the year, they have looked very smart.

As we return to normal temperatures, we will expect the full school uniform to be worn appropriately. This means blazers should be on and shirts tucked in. If students need extra warmth, they can wear a plain navy blue or black jumper, but this must not have logos. To be clear the blazer is compulsory but jumpers are not.

A few other uniform reminders:

- No stretchy skirts
- Socks must be ankle socks only.
- Footwear must be completely black
- Jewellery: one pair of stud earrings, a watch and a nose stud are allowed, but no other jewellery.
- Hair colours must be natural and tram lines in hair or lines shaved into brows are not permitted.
- Nails must be short and not coloured. False eyelashes are also not permitted
- No hoodies allowed on site

Students should also remember to bring their card and lanyard, as this is needed for purchasing of food, and a refillable water bottle to keep hydrated.
