



We are pleased that 91% parents agree with this statement. We know that the post-Covid journey still has some way to go, so we will continue to support our students with academic catch up and their wellbeing.




Students' Happiness




Teaching

Teachers take part in continual training at RPCC so that teaching is constantly improving. We are pleased that 86% parents agree that children are well taught at RPCC.




Concerns / Issues


Of those of you who have contacted us we are pleased that 82% feel that concerns were dealt with. We pride ourselves on our relationships with parents and families and will continue to improve this.







Leadership Opportunities


Students are given leadership opportunities at RPCC.
